Sharing Your Life Message

POINT TO MEDITATE ABOUT FROM LAST WEEK:

God created you with the purpose in mind of preaching to others.

- 1) Your mission is a continuation of Jesus' mission on Earth
- 2) Your mission is a wonderful privilege
- 3) Telling others how they can get Eternal Life is the greatest thing you can do for them
- 4) Your mission has eternal significance
- 5) Your mission gives your life meaning
- 6) God's timetable for history's conclusion is connected to the completion of your mission

VERSE TO MEMORIZE FROM LAST WEEK:

- Matthew 28:19 (NIV)
 - 19) "Go and make disciples of all nations."

QUESTION TO CONSIDER FROM LAST WEEK:

What fears have kept me from sharing the Truth with people I know?

- The absolute best way to reach people is by sharing YOUR LIFE MESSAGE
- God has given you a message about your life that He wants you to share with those around you
 - God wants to speak to the world through you
- You may think you don't have any Message to tell
- But, that is not true...
- 1st John 5:9-10 NIV
 - 9) We accept man's testimony, but God's testimony is greater because it is the testimony of God, which he has given about his Son.

- 10) Anyone who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in his heart.
- EVERYONE that believes in the Son of God has this testimony in his heart
 - That means you!
- What is your Life Message?
- Your Life Message contains 4 main parts:
- 1) Your Life Message Contains Your **TESTIMONY**
- Your **Testimony** is the Message of how **God has made a difference** in your life
- 1st Peter 2:9 (Message)
 - 9) But you are the ones chosen by God, chosen for the high calling of priestly work, chosen to be a holy people, God's instruments to do his work and speak out for him, to tell others of the night-and-day difference he made for you
- This is the essence of witnessing...
 - Simply sharing your personal experiences about God with someone else
- In a courtroom, witnesses aren't expected to argue the case, quote the law, prove the point or press for a verdict...
 - Witnesses simply report what happened to them
 - But, it's the witnesses that convince the jury!
- God calls us to be Witnesses, not Attorneys
 - He simply wants us to share our Testimony with others
- Sharing your Testimony is an essential part of your **Life Message** because it is unique
 - There is no other Testimony just like yours, so only you can share it
 - If you don't share it, then it will be lost forever
- You may not be a Bible Scholar, but you are an authority on YOUR life
 - It's hard to argue with personal experience
- Shared stories build bridges between people, and allow relationships to grow

- It's through these relationships with others that the Gospel spreads from your heart to theirs
- Many people are put off by the Bible, and won't listen to talk about it
 - But, people will listen to a humble, personal Message
- Personal stories capture our attention and we remember them
- Consider the Apostle Paul...
 - No one else in the Bible uses Testimony as often as Paul
- On **SIX** separate occasions we have records of Paul sharing his Life's Message instead of

quoting Scripture

- Paul wrote:
- 1st Peter 3:15 (Message)
 - 15) Be ready to speak up and tell anyone who asks **why you're living the way you are**, and always with the utmost courtesy.
- The best way for you to be ready, is to **write out your testimony**, and memorize the main points
- Most Testimonies easily divide into **four** different parts:
 - a) What your life was like **before** you came to the Truth
 - b) What made you realize that you needed to be baptized
 - c) How you went about **committing** your life to Christ
 - d) The difference in your life since coming to God
- You will probably want to focus on different parts of this message...
 - You probably have a different Message for every experience in which God has helped you
 - Depending on who you are talking to, what the context is, and where they are in their life, you can custom-fit your Message to your audience
- But, the message is always the same...
 - God has brought meaning and purpose to your life, and they can have it also if they simply turn to God...

And you can show them how!

2) Your Life Message Contains Your LIFE LESSONS

- You know certain truths that God has taught you from your experiences with Him
 - These are lessons and insights you have learned about God, relationships, problems, temptations and other aspects of life
- These **Life Lessons** are incredibly valuable to the people around you who are continually struggling with life's problems, temptations and relationships
- Sadly, we often don't learn from what happens to us
 - While it is **wise** to learn from **experience**, it is even **wiser** to learn from the **experiences of others**
- There isn't enough time in life to learn everything by trial and error
 - We should learn by the Life Lessons of one another
- Proverbs 25:12 (TEV)
 - 12) A warning given by an experienced person to someone willing to listen is more valuable than jewelry made of the finest gold.
- To get the maximum benefit from the troubles you experience in life
 - Keep a journal of the spiritual lessons you have learned
- Write down your major Life Lessons...
 - And be brave enough to share them with the people around you
- Look at your life and see what lessons you can extract that will be helpful to others
 - What has God taught me from failure?
 - What has God taught me from a lack of money?
 - What has God taught me from pain and sorrow?
 - What has God taught me from **depression**?
 - What has God taught me from waiting?
 - What has God taught me from illnesses?
 - What has God taught me from disappointment?
 - What has God taught me from my family?
 - What has God taught me from my ecclesia?
 - What has God taught me from my critics?

3) Your Life Message Contains Your GODLY PASSIONS

- God is a Passionate God!
 - He passionately loves some things
 - He passionately hates other things
- As you grow closer to God…
 - You begin to adopt this same characteristic
 - You become more Passionate about the things that God cares about
- Whether it's a problem, a purpose, a principle, or a group of people...
 - You will feel compelled to speak up about it and do what you can to make a difference
- You'll find that you cannot keep yourself from talking about what you care about most
- You sometimes find yourself in the same position as Jeremiah:
- Jeremiah 20:9 (CEV)
 - 9) Sometimes I tell myself not to think about you, LORD, or even mention your name. But your message burns in my heart and bones, and I cannot keep silent.
- Your Passion is often related to something you have experienced yourself
 - Abuse
 - Addiction
 - Infertility
 - Depression
 - Illness
 - Joblessness
 - Lack of Faith
- Your Passion may be related to a group of people who can't speak for themselves:
 - Young children
 - The poor
 - The imprisoned
 - The disadvantaged
 - Anyone denied justice
 - To defend the defenseless

- Your Passion might be for a purpose:
 - Starting a new Ecclesia
 - Strengthening Families
 - Promoting Bible Study
 - Improving Marriages
 - Mentoring Leaders
 - Visiting the Sick
 - Encouraging the Elderly
- Your Passion may be to reach out to a group of people you feel close to
 - Businessmen
 - Teenagers
 - Young Mothers
 - People on the "Outside"
 - Certain Nationalities
 - People with a certain hobby
- God gives us all different passions so that everything He wants done will get done
- Speak openly and freely about your passions to others...
 - Because God is speaking through you to bring them to His Gospel
- 4) Your **Life Message** Contains The **GOOD NEWS**
- The last, and most important facet of your Life Message is God's Message
- The Good News of the Gospel
- 2nd Corinthians 5:19 (NLT)
 - 19) For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. This is the wonderful message he has given us to tell others.
- The **Good News** is that we have learned that
 - We can trust God's grace to save us through the sacrifice of Jesus
 - Our sins are forgiven
 - We are given a place in God's Kingdom
- We are compelled, inspired and motivated to share this Good News with others...
 - When we come to appreciate the value of it in our lives

- Romans 1:17 (NLT)
 - 17) This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. **This is** accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, "It is through faith that a righteous person has life."
- Our Life Message has to include this amazing and wonderful message
 - This hope is what carries us through the dark times
- The knowledge of the grace that we have been given motivates us to serve God
- The death of our Lord is what really motivates us to share God's Word with others
- 2nd Corinthians 5:14 (NIV)
 - 14) For **Christ's love compels us**, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.
- To realize that God loved that person who works in the cubicle beside you SOOOO much that he allowed His only son to die so that that person might live...
 - That <u>HAS</u> to motivate you to reach beyond your comfort zone, and say something meaningful to the person beside you
- A parent will run into a burning building to save the life of their child
 - Because their love for the child is so strong
- For you to be successful at reaching out to others, you have to ask God to fill your heart with love for the people around you
- God doesn't want anyone to be lost
 - God wants everyone to be saved
- As long as you know one person who hasn't come to the Truth, you must keep praying for them, serving them in love, and sharing the Good News with them
- Sometimes you hear people complaining that we don't have any good pamphlets to give to people
- God has prepared something MUCH better
- God has YOU!

- God wants you to use YOUR LIFE MESSAGE to bring all nations to repentance
 - God wants you to use YOUR LIFE MESSAGE to save your next door neighbor!
