- This process of transforming yourself is called DISCIPLESHIP
- Discipleship is your 3rd PURPOSE

Since, then, we do not have the excuse of ignorance, everything - and I do mean everything - connected with that old way of life has to go. It's rotten through and through. Get rid of it! And then take on an entirely new way of life - a God-fashioned life,

a life renewed from the inside

and working itself into your conduct as God accurately reproduces His character in you.

God's Desire for You

- God's ultimate goal for you is not comfort, but CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT
- Life is SUPPOSED to be difficult
- You exist for GOD'S PURPOSE, not vice-versa



You Can't Do It Yourself

- It is the job of God's HOLY SPIRIT to produce a Christ-like character in you
- You cannot reproduce the character of Christ by YOURSELF



Philippians 2:13 (NIV)

13) ...for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.



Becoming like Christ is not about
IMITATION - It's about INHABITATION

Colossians 1:27 (Message)

27)

God wanted everyone, not just Jews, to know this rich and glorious secret inside and out, regardless of their background, regardless of their religious standing. The mystery in a nutshell is just this: Christ is in you, therefore you can look forward to sharing in God's glory. It's that simple. That is the substance of our Message.

- Becoming like Christ is not about IMITATION - It's about INHABITATION
- The power of God is released in your life the moment you take a STEP OF FAITH
 - **OBEDIENCE** unlocks God's power



- God's WORD provides the Truth that you need to grow

Romans 12:2 (Message)

2)

Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.

DISCIPLESHIP

- Discipleship is the PROCESS of becoming like Christ
- Discipleship always begins with a COMMITMENT
- The COMMITMENTS that you make either develop you or destroy you

- 12) Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed - not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence - continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling,
- 13) for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.





Spiritual Growth

- The first step to Spiritual Growth is to CHANGE THE WAY YOU THINK
- The first part of changing the way you think is to STOP THINKING SELF-CENTERED THOUGHTS

1st Corinthians 14:20 (NIV)

20) Brothers, stop thinking like children. In regard to evil be infants, but in your thinking be adults.





Spiritual Growth

 - The second part of changing the way you think is to START FOCUSING ON OTHERS and not on yourself

Resisting Change

- The Truth shall set you free...But, first it might MAKE YOU MISERABLE
- God's word exposes your motives, points out your faults, rebukes your sins and EXPECTS YOU TO CHANGE
 - It's human nature to resist change, so applying God's word is HARD WORK

Life is a "Series of Problems"

- God uses PROBLEMS to draw you closer to Him
- It's during suffering that you learn to PRAY
- Problems force you to DEPEND ON GOD

2nd Corinthians 1:8-10 (Message)

8) We don't want you in the dark, friends, about how hard it was when all this came down on us in Asia province. It was so bad we didn't think we were going to make it.

> We felt like we'd been sent to death row, that it was all over for us. As it turned out, it was the best thing that could have happened. Instead of trusting in our own strength or wits to get out of it, we were forced to trust God totally - not a bad idea since he's the God who raises the dead!

Keep your eyes on *Jesus*, who both began and finished this race we're in. Study how he did it. Because he never lost sight of where he was headed - that exhilarating finish with God - he could put up with anything along the way: cross, shame, whatever. And now he's *there*, in the place of honor, right alongside God.

When you find yourselves flagging in your faith, go over that story again, item by item, that long litany of hostility he plowed through. *That* will shoot adrenaline into your souls!

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things.

16) Make this your common practice: Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you can live together whole and healed. The prayer of a person living right with God is something powerful to be reckoned with.

1st Corinthians 10:12 (Message)

Don't be so naive and self-confident. You're not exempt. You could fall flat on your face as easily as anyone else. Forget about self-confidence; it's useless. Cultivate God-confidence.

2nd Corinthians 3:18 (Message)

18)

All of us! Nothing between us and God, our faces shining with the brightness of His face. And so we are transfigured much like the Messiah, our lives gradually becoming brighter and more beautiful as God enters our lives and we become like Him.

- 2. We have a lot to UNLEARN
- 3. We are AFRAID to face the truth
- 4. Growth is PAINFUL AND SCARY
- 5. HABITS take time to develop
